Overview of Enrolment Procedure

ADMISSION

Congratulations! You have been accepted in to the Ghent University Global Campus (GUGC) programme Joint Section Bachelor in Environmental Technology, Food Technology and Molecular Biotechnology! Your Letter of Admission has been sent to you via email and is also available in the Oasis system (your application file). This document covers the necessary next steps.

TUITION FEE

After reception of the letter of admission, you will receive an invoice for the basic fixed fee via email, which must be paid in order to start actual enrolment. Deadline for payment is included with the invoice. Invoices are usually issued within one week of the letter of admission. Once the basic fixed fee is processed, applicants will receive access to their enrolment file.

Note: Full tuition payment for the first semester is required before the semester begins. Installment payment options are also available. If you choose to pay in installments, the finance department will provide you with a detailed payment schedule later.

VISA

Applicants needing a visa to study in Korea must submit a Certificate of Admission as part of their visa application at the Korean embassy. The Certificate of Admission will be sent to you via email within three weeks of payment of the basic fixed fee.

DOCUMENTS

Submit any remaining documents (If not yet completed during the application)

- Valid international passport
- Final diploma/certificate of graduation and transcript
- International (school) diplomas: legalised version of your diploma and transcript

Note: If you have not graduated yet and do not expect to receive your certificate of graduation before semester begins, please inform us: admission@ghent.ac.kr

ENROLMENT

Confirm your enrolment via the Oasis system

Enrolment is only possible after the basic fixed fee and all documents have been received in good order. You must confirm enrolment yourself via your application file in OASIS, preferably **by 15 February 2026 for the preparatory semester, and by 1 August 2026 for the Fall semester.**

Enrolment will be open

- Preparatory semester(March 2026): from 15 January 2026
- Academic Year 2026-2027: from 1 July 2026

Note: Preparatory semester students should enrol via the enrolment file 2025-2026 "Preparatory semester Ghent University Global Campus"

ACCOUNT

Activation of GUGC e-mail account (@ghent.ac.kr)

Your account and email address will be active at the latest 1-3 days after enrolment.

This email account is used for all official communications, so check it regularly!

Use the account to login into the digital learning environment Ufora.
